- Artists should be students/and or residents in the Acton or Agua Dulce area in Grades K-12.
 Minimum age: 5 years old and in Kindergarten
 Maximum age: 18 years old and in 12th Grade
- Artists may enter up to 4 pieces of <u>original</u>, <u>hanging</u> artwork. (We are only able to display hanging artwork in a frame or stretched canvas mounted on a frame with finished edges <u>and</u> with a hanging wire.



Pick up artwork after reception – library closes at 6:00 PM

<u>Preparation</u>: Artwork must be framed or be stretched canvas mounted on frame with edges painted or finished with tape and wired. Artwork <u>does not</u> have to be professionally framed. A purchased frame from a retail outlet or a repurposed frame that is framed by artist or parents is acceptable. <u>All artwork must include a hanging wire</u>. (Hobby Lobby can add a hanging wire to an existing frame for \$3). We will not be able to hang your artwork without a frame and a hanging wire. A hook is not adequate for the hanging system used in the library. Artist's name and title of artwork must be neatly printed or labeled on back of artwork.

Back of Frame

Hanging wire goes from one side of frame to the other and is secured with a screw or bracket. **No string. No tape. No staples. No hot glue.** Mount wire 1/3 the distance from the top of the frame. Arch of wire should be about 1" from top of frame.
